

Dear Parents and Carers,

Congratulations to our YR children who raised £34.22 thanks to our lovely PTA, who organised the event. Please see our PTA news box below for details. Their chosen charity was Canine Partners

Maple Class have had a very informative visit to West Dean Gardens, today, with Mrs. Cannig, Mrs. Graham and Mrs. Pinnington. They learnt a lot about leaves and plants, as well as enjoying the beautiful surroundings.



Beech class children had a visit from local historian, Paul Ulson, who explored Stone Age history with them, in a very 'hands on' and exciting way. "We acted out what happened and travelled through time, stopping off in the Palaeolithic; Mesolithic and Neolithic while learning how Britain changed.

We created a man called Ugg and acted out his life of killing animals, discovering new weapons and being a Nomad" Keturah Peirson (Year 4)

"Paul Ulson showed us some different types of animal fur and told us all about them. He showed us some bags made out of different animal skins" Holly Wilburn (Year 4).

This week we have had a strange timetable in school as our KS2 children did their tests, and our Y6 pupils did their SATs tests. I must congratulate all of the children for the positive approach they had to this. We have put a new scheme of Y2,3,4 and 5 tests in place to give us information to help track progress and identify next steps for children. This has not been possible until this year due to the change of curriculum and assessment methodology, but we feel that these tests, which are closely aligned to the Y6 tests and give us a standardised score, will support our teacher assessment judgements and give the children valuable practice of tests.

Chestnut Class have watched part of Beauty and the Beast, this afternoon, after gaining the consent of Mrs. Moss. They did this by writing persuasive letters, pointing out how hard they have worked, how much the film will help them in their writing, and how it will aid them in understanding the genre and plot of Cyrano de Bergerac and similar stories. Mrs. Moss was impressed by their letters, pleased that they appreciated her dedication to every West Dean pupil, and keen to support their learning. Please see a sample of the letters below.




Ms Pleasance will be absent from Apple class following the death of her mother. Mrs Chilton will be in Apple Class full time for the foreseeable future, with additional support.
