GOVERNOR INFORMATION

The Governing Body met on the 10^{th} March. The meeting started with a presentation by Mrs Canning about her collaborative work with partner schools in the locality, and the benefits of sharing good practice and ideas. During the next part of the meeting governors fed back on their visits to school.

Mrs Hugason-Briem had attended a SEN meeting and was informed of the breadth of support pupils receive to reach their full potential, and the effective use of pupil premium funding. Mrs Parks was impressed with how pupils were working together in Beech Class, and how their learning was monitored to track progress.

On the agenda was also the Head Teacher's Report. The report included how the school had recently been preparing for the forthcoming Church School (SIAMS) Inspection, information on the new assessment systems, and an update on the Impact workshops. We also heard about the exciting shared activities pupils had been involved with such as World Book Day and Alive and Kicking week. Plans for the new building project were also discussed, and ways forward were agreed.

The governors also heard about the success of the second community café run by Chestnut Class and how well they coped with their interviews and job training. A lot of work has been happening behind the scenes on making sure all school policies are up to date, for ratification at the next governor meeting on Thursday 21st April.
