West Dean ❤️ Xilitla

We are delighted that, due to the efforts and determination of one of our governors, Sharon-Michi Kusunoki, and Alex Barron from West Dean College, our link with the community in Xilitla, Mexico, has been re-established and communication between our two schools has started. Our otherwise vastly contrasting communities are uniquely and rather wonderfully connected through the life and work of Edward James and we are very excited that there is now real potential for our children to work with the children of Xilitla on some online collaborative project work.

At this stage, Miss Karye, a teacher from the primary school in San Luis Potosi, Xilitla, is communicating with Mr Williams, but we aim to extend this to the other teachers and children soon. This week, the children in Xilitla celebrated *Dia de muertos* or *Day of the Dead* and sent us this photo of them all in incredible costumes at school.



During our collective worship this morning, we talked to the children about *Dia de muertos* and how it is a significant family festival in Mexico. Although it has similar origins to the Christian observation of *All Hallows*, *All Saints* and *All Souls* days, and the subsequent popular culture celebration of *Halloween*, *Dia de muertos* is more about families coming together to celebrate the lives of relatives who are no longer with them. Yes, lots of the costumes include skull masks, but they are also full of colour and often decorated with flowers too. It is going to be really beneficial for our children to develop this connection and learn about a contrasting culture in another part of our world. Watch this space for more news...
