
Adults in Chestnut Class

We are excited to welcome Mrs Huxham to West Dean and more importantly to Chestnut Class! Mrs Huxham will be working on Mondays; Mrs Johnson will be working Tuesday to Friday and Mrs Goacher will be our teaching assistant every day.

Our theme this term is 'Evolve and Solve'.

This term amongst many things we will be learning about Evolution and Inheritance.

To help us learn, we will read a range of fiction and non-fiction including the book 'Darwin's Dragons' by Lindsay Galvin. This will provide us with many writing opportunities as well as a wealth of science-based learning and research.





Please continue to encourage your child to read regularly at home. Pupils should record details of their reading in their **Homework Diary**. We expect at least 3 reads per week (ideally, for at least 20 minutes) and one of these reads will be to an adult. Diaries will be checked each **Friday**.



Spelling homework will be set each **Monday** and should be **completed and handed in by the following Monday**. Details of spelling homework will be available on our Google classroom.



Mathematics homework will be set each **Thursday** and should be completed and handed in by the following **Tuesday.**

Details of homework, as well as our weekly timetable and many of our class lesson resources will be accessible to pupils on our Google classroom site. Some reminders to the children will be posted here, but any important whole class information will continue to be sent out via eSchools email.



As with all online communication, at this age we encourage you to monitor your child's Google Classroom account and do come and tell us immediately if there is anything that causes you or your child concern. We of course monitor this in school as well.
