CHECK YOUR INBOX! Thank you to those parents who came along to our two meetings on **Monday 13th May.** We appreciate your engagement in this important process.





This will be in our beautiful school grounds and we are hoping for the perfect, warm summer evening to enjoy the West Dean ambience along with delicious food and a drink on arrival.


