Plans have been well under way for preparing our swimming pool ready for use after half term. Abbie is busy putting together a rota for Supervisors and helpers for our after school swim slots, 3.00-4.00. We



had arranged a poolside first aid training session, thank you to everyone who came along.

It is crucial that we have enough helpers who are first aid trained to help us cover all of our after school swimming sessions. Each session must have a first aider and a supervisor, without this we cannot open the pool for the children after school. Please do help if you can.

Booking can be made on schoolmoney.co.uk, places are limited to 12 per session each day, £3.50 per child. Parents/carers must remain with their children during afterschool swim sessions.

The swimming pool is ready for us to use after half term, weather permitting. The children will have the opportunity to swim every day so will need to have a named swimming kit and towel in a named bag in school.

We do have some spare towels and costumes but we are also in need if you have any outgrown clothing that you could donate.

Please ensure that your child has sun cream applied in the morning, before they come into school and a hat.

We are really hoping for lots of warm, sunny days so that we can make the most of our lovely pool.


PTA Indian Supper Club Saturday 22nd June, 7.00pm.
