The below email explains a little about our new booking system, which is now live and how parents can access it.

We know change can be a hassle but trust us - this new booking system is going to make your life easier!

Designed to streamline your admin for clubs, camps and sports sessions, the new booking and payment process will be faster and easier than ever before.

Here's what you can expect from the upgraded iPAL Bookings System:

- Create your own profile where you can book, view and manage all your child(ren's) activities in one place
- Instead of making separate, time-consuming bookings for each sibling, you will be able to set up multiple children on your profile.
  If you have more than one child, this will greatly improve your booking experience.
- Your profile will include your **child's information** such as DOB, allergies, medical requirements and SEND, so you no longer need to input this every time you make a booking.
- Childcare vouchers for holiday camps will be automatically reconciled so you will not need to advise that payment has been made
- Your profile will provide you with easy access to receipts as and when you need them
- If your child joins an activity part-way through term, the booking system will **automatically show the price for the remaining ses**sions
- On the rare occasion we need to cancel a session due to weather, or get in touch with all parents at the last minute, we will be able to do so quickly and efficiently
- You will now have access to a **mobile app**. The iPAL Parent App is designed for parents like you. It is very user-friendly and provides convenient access to the booking system right from your smartphone. You can easily view available slots, make bookings and receive important updates all at your fingertips!
