As a consequence of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Government has decided to allocate funding for every school to help support children whose progress has suffered. Below is our breakdown of how we have allocated this funding to maximise its use.

Tutors x3	3 hours per week (approx. £135 per week)	£900 (Aut 20) £600 (Sum 21)	3 tutors supporting vulnerable children in separate bubbles to ensure adherence to Covid safety guidance, during the Autumn term, suspended during lockdown period, resumed in the summer term with 2 p/t tutors
Teaching Staff - Lunchtime Cover & Teaching Assistant Support	3 hours per week (approx. £100 per week)	£3000	To ensure lunch time provision is adequate to allow children to remain in their bubbles. Teaching staff covering lunch duty incorporating learning, eg some French language learning, use of IT to watch news reports etc during lunch
PE/Sports Coach (External)	1 hour per week @ £15 × 38	£550	Additional sports coaching on top of current provision, to support children during lunch time, playing team games and socialising
Forest School - Teaching Ass Support	Amount used towards the provision of forest School	£800	Support for initial set-up and staff training in Forest School, a vital part of our curriculum to make best use of our extensive grounds and outdoor areas for the children in all weather
ICT	Clever Touch TVs	£1000	Purchase of new IT equipment to support remote learning and to ensure the smooth and effective running of Google Classrooms during lockdown.
Staff Wellbeing Programme	After school, Zoom, exercise programme, 3 hours per week, during lockdown period, Jan-Mar 2021. Subsidised by Covid funding, staff also contributed towards the cost.	£500	To support staff wellbeing during the lockdown period and to support the fitness instructors in their businesses. This was very much appreciated by staff and was offered to governors, a vital programme when staff needed care alongside our children.
General Curriculum	Misc general curriculum provision and resources	£500	Contingency to support staff and children identified where necessary
