Big News! There was huge excitement in school yesterday morning, as we revealed to the children that we will be preparing and performing a production of The Lion King this summer. Please save the date of **Monday 14th July**, as this will be performance night. We have once again very kindly been given use of the fantastic, large marquee at West Dean College for the production. You do not need an expert knowledge of The Lion King musical to know that a huge number of animals feature in the story. We hope to bring this to life for the children through a mixture of costume and puppetry. To launch this idea (and let's be honest, to create a bit of a buzz around the whole subject), we invited Liam, a professional puppeteer into school yesterday, along with the most incredible, enormous 'Beast' puppet, which featured in a past production of *Beauty and The Beast* at Chichester Festival Theatre—you may have been lucky enough to see it.

It was a certainly a memorable experience; not only did it well and truly create the desired excitement in the children, but also a lot of laughs too—it's not every day your head teacher is cuddled, yes cuddled, by 10ft tall beast during your school assembly! Liam taught the children all about the importance of assuming the character of the puppet as the human operator, even though the focus of the audience is on the puppet itself. For the second half of this term, after the break at the end of May, our learning across the school will focus on the many aspects of production preparation, not just rehearsals, but animal

research, puppet making and all manner of other things too.
