Having learnt about explorer Ernest Shackleton earlier this term and about various animals that inhabit the polar regions, the children were keen to meet a modern day explorer. Dr Roterman has travelled extensively in the Southern Ocean including a dive in a submarine to a depth of over 2500 metres. He discovered a new species of crab, never seen before and met all kinds of wildlife along the way including King Penguins! Thank you very much to Dr Roterman, the children were very inspired by his visit.
